Robo Vikes Reign Supreme: Nolan Catholic Celebrates World Championship Triumph!

Nolan Catholic is thrilled to announce the outstanding achievements of our robotics Team 4206, the Robo Vikes, at the FIRST World Championship Event that took place April 17-19 in Houston. The Robo Vikes emerged as the 2024 World Championship Archimedes Division Winner and secured the prestigious 3rd Alliance in the world, surpassing over 600 teams worldwide. Notably, they showcased exceptional performance with multiple high scores in Einstein's, the final matches in



Worlds. Additionally, the team achieved the Highest Clean Score in the competition, demonstrating remarkable precision with the least amount of penalties, and came within 7 points of setting a new World Record. They also earned the distinction of the Highest Losing Score, reflecting their unmatched prowess even in defeat, and attained the Highest Telecommunication Operation Score, showcasing their mastery when the driver is in control of the robot.

We extend our heartfelt gratitude to the donors, parents, mentors, coaches, and volunteers whose unwavering support with their resources, time, talent, advice, and expertise propelled the Robo Vikes to such extraordinary success.

Moreover, we commend the students for their resilience in times of failure, their grit, and determination to rebuild Carson (the robot) under extreme pressures, and their admirable sense of humor amidst challenges. Your dedication and spirit embody the essence of Esto Dux - leading the way to excellence. Congratulations once again to the Robo Vikes for this remarkable achievement!

Math League National Championship



But the most significant connections made in this garden involve the statue itself. Max, like so many of our Nolan Catholic students, is involved in a range of activities. Through this connection, Coach Taylor and his wife Margaret gifted the statue in honor of Margaret's parents, Aurora and Raymond Burciaga.






