

## Greening the Campus: Troop 97's Compost Crusade



Last weekend scouts and parents from St. Andrew's Boy Scout troop 97 spent a gorgeous Saturday morning building a three-bin compost system for the garden. Junior Nicholas Ritchey spearheaded the project to satisfy one of the requirements for his Eagle rank. The scouts not only did a stellar job building the bins, they also transferred compost from our old single bin to the new system, and moved cinder blocks and concrete to make wheel-barrow accessible pathways to the bins.

Students have been talking with Mr. Garnett and Mrs. Breclaw for years about composting at the school. Until now, we've only been able to handle composting materials from the garden and scraps

from floral design. Now we can include coffee grounds from around campus, and eventually scraps from the cafeteria and culinary program. In turn, we will use the compost to enhance the raised beds in the garden area and courtyard. This will help us grow stronger plants and save money by not having to purchase compost and soil amendments.

We are so grateful to the hard work and dedication of troop 97. Last year they built four raised beds in our community garden. We're using those to grow garlic, sweet potatoes and potatoes. Over the next month, we'll see more exciting changes in the garden with another scout project that will bring more landscape beds, seating, and a very special statue to the garden.






