Schedule:

5:15-5:30 PM -- Check in with a Nolan Catholic staff member in the Arena lobby.

5:30 PM -- NCHS staff member escorts middle schoolers to Dance Studio where future Vikings will meet the Royelles Directors and Dance Team.

5:30-6:15 PM -- Learn routines and how to hold poms

6:30 PM -- Depart for the football field; parents are welcome to grab a seat in the stands to watch the pregame football festivities.

Q1 and Q2 - Dance in the stands with Royelles!

End of Q2 - NCHS staff will dismiss middle school students to their parent/guardian to watch the halftime show. Parents, please pick up your student at the concrete slab between the stairs and the concession at the bottom of the steps.

What to Wear

Clothes you can dance in! Preferably a blue, white, or black shirt (an NCHS shirt is fine), and athletic shorts or leggings. Tennis shoes are fine.
