Steve Holleman and his wife Paige have owned and operated Kona Ice Northwest DFW for nine years. They serve specific zip codes in west and northwest Tarrant County.

Kona Ice is the largest mobile food truck franchise in the USA serving gourmet shaved ice at schools, sporting events, weddings, corporate employee treats, and festivals.

Many of the school and sporting events include a giveback to help provide financial support to the school or nonprofit sports leagues. Collectively, Kona Ice has donated over \$82 million dollars across the country.

Steve & Paige were asked to assist the franchise headquarters in the development of a new food truck, Grounded Coffee Transit, and they will be operating the prototype truck locally during the month of February.




Oliver Gallina '17 was named to the University of Utah's Fall 2020 Dean's List. Gallina is majoring in Games BS.
